Our Community Deserves the Best Facilities and Care

THE Albury Wodonga Regional Cancer Centre has united cancer services under one roof offering a place to educate, support, research, diagnose and treat all forms of cancer.

The facility includes:

- 30 inpatient beds;
- 28-chair day chemotherapy facility;
- 17 medical and allied health consulting rooms;
- 'Wellness Centre' (offering support services and complementary therapies such as massage, mindfulness and counselling);
- An education and training facility;
- Two paediatric treatment chairs connected to the children's ward; and,
- A PET/CT scanner facility on the Albury Hospital site.
